
OUR MISSION


OUR HISTORY

Following a 21year effort by the Board of Trustees and the community, the newly renovated theatre was reopened on October 9, 1999. Since then, more than a million people have attended international, national and regional presentations, weddings and events.

Valentine Receives \$150,000 Capital Grant



The Valentine was recently awarded a \$150,000 grant from the State of Ohio's 2025-26 biennial capital budget. The funding will be used for much needed renovations, including a new boiler and new curtains for our Main Stage. Many thanks to our board members and elected officials, especially Senator Theresa Gavarone and Representative Paula Hicks-Hudson, who tirelessly championed the Valentine during the legislative process.

The total cost for these projects exceeds \$225,000, so we will be launching a one-time "Raise the Curtain" campaign to secure the additional funding. And, as December 25, 2025, will mark the Valentine Theatre's 130th Anniversary, what better way to celebrate than with new curtains on our Main Stage! More information on how you can help us "Raise the Curtain" will be coming in the next few months. As a special thank-you, donors who give \$130 or more will be invited to an exclusive, sneak peek party on our Main Stage, where you will enjoy a champagne toast and complimentary hors d'oeuvres. A Look Back in Time

"Toledoans Hear Helen Keller" - More than 110 years ago, on November 17, 1913, Helen Keller gave a lecture at

the Valentine Theatre with her teacher, Mrs. Annie Sullivan Macy. She was invited to speak under the auspices of the Daughters of St. Mark's Church. Miss Keller's message of love and tolerance was warmly received by the Toledoans who attended. She spoke of the great obstacles she overcame in her life and how important individuals are to

each other. After speaking, she took questions from the audience. Although she was both blind and deaf and never heard herself or anyone else speak, a reporter for the Blade wrote that "she addressed the large assembly ... in forceful and accurate English...[and] the wonderful Miss Keller [was] found distinctly worth while by the ... assembly of Toledoans that heard and saw [her]."

KISS at the Valentine — Fifty years ago this month the



70's glam rock group, KISS, performed at the Valentine. On Saturday, October 19, 1974, the infamous rockers — Paul Stanley (rhythm guitar), Gene Simmons (bass), Ace Frehley (lead guitar), and Peter Criss (drums) — appeared with special guests the Rockets. In fact, several musical groups performed at what was then the Renaissance Valentine Theatre during 1974 as part of a last ditch effort by its owners to keep the theatre open. Among

other groups performing in 1974 were Kansas and southern rockers Lynyrd Skynrd.

Year-End Gift

With a Tax-Free Gift from Your IRA

If you are 70½ or older, you can make an annual tax-free gift, up to \$100,000, to the Valentine from your Traditional or Roth Individual Retirement Account (IRA). Your gift will count towards your Required Minimum Distribution. Gifts must be submitted before December 31st to be eligible in the current year.

<u>Advantages</u>

- Benefit the Valentine Theatre in a meaningful way
 - No income tax on the IRA withdrawal
- Meet your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD)

How it Works

- ◆ Ask your IRA account administrator to mail your gift in the form of a check directly to the Valentine Theatre, 410 Adams ST, Toledo, OH 4304. Our tax ID is 34-1385037.
