
# CONDITIONS OF TICKET SALES & THEATRE POLICIES

- All sales are final. No refunds or exchanges.
- No tickets will be held or reserved without full payment. Return check fee of \$35.
- The Theatre and Box Office open one hour before the advertised show time and seating begins one half-hour before show time.

#### DIRECTIONS TO THE THEATRE

The Valentine Theatre is located at the corner of Superior St. and Adams St. in the heart of downtown Toledo.

#### From I-75 Northbound

Take the Downtown Toledo Exit. Turn left at light and go North on Erie St. to Adams St. (5 blocks). Turn right on Adams to Superior (2 blocks). The Theatre is located on the Northeast corner.

#### From I-75 Southbound

Take the Washington St./Downtown Toledo Exit. Turn right at the second light, onto Washington. Take Washington East to Erie St. (3 blocks). Turn left at light and go North on Erie to Adams St. (5 blocks). Turn right on Adams to Superior St. (2 blocks). Theatre is located on the Northeast corner.

#### **PARKING**

There are several parking lots within one block of the Theatre. The Downtown Parking Authority operates two garages, one on Superior St., south of Adams St., and the other on Superior, north of Jackson St. (The Vistula Garage). Kwik Parking operates the surface lot across Superior from the Theatre. The Ampco Garage is located on St. Clair St. (one block east of the Theatre) in the Four SeaGate Building. Parking rates vary by lots. Free parking is available at meters on the street after 6 p.m. weekdays and all day on weekends.
